
- ✤ A separate Entry Form must be filled in for the Prime Cattle Section
- Entries close on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> April 2025
- Correct Entry Fee must accompany Entry Form to be accepted no change given
- All cattle must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor for at least three (3) months prior to Show Date
- All Exhibitors and passengers are required to pay Gate Admission unless the holder of a pass, Life Membership or Membership Ticket
- All Cattle are to be delivered to the Showgrounds on Friday 25th April 2025 by 4.00pm
- To be exhibited and judged on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2025
- ✤ Judging to commence at 9.00am
- Cattle will be fed overnight by the Show Society
- All Cattle will be purchased by Maclagan Meats and Oakey Beef Exports
- ✤ Grain, Grain Assisted and Grassfed will compete against each other
- ↔ Weighing of Cattle will be the responsibility of the owner
- The owner is responsible for identifying the beast, by inserting an Eartag with a number (no name, number only) (this number will be supplied on acceptance of Entry by the Chief Steward) tag to be supplied by the owner
- All cattle to be tagged with an NLIS device
- The Chief Steward reserves the right to reject any entries that do not meet the market requirements
- All Cattle must be HGP FREE

# Goombungee-Haden A. H. & P. Society Inc Conditions of Entry

- 1. Gates will open to the public 8.00am on Show day.
- 2. Competitors shall endeavor to send a detailed list of articles they intend to submit for competition. Where possible the list should be delivered to the Secretary at least 3 days before the Show. Each Article on delivery should be correctly labelled with Section and Class details. Entry Fees should accompany each entry.
- 3. No discount on entry fees will be allowed other than the Membership Entitlement of 10% discount when fees are paid before the 1<sup>st</sup> March 2025.
- 4. Exhibits will be received in accordance with the regulations set out in this Schedule.
- 5. No exhibitor will be allowed to remove or in any way interfere with any exhibit until 5.00pm Show day, unless with permission from the Steward concerned or the Secretary.
- 6. Agricultural and Horticultural Produce and Home Cooking must be grown or made by the exhibitor.
- 7. The Judge may award a second or third place instead of a first, or may withhold a prize altogether, when the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
- 8. Where exhibits bear the name of an exhibitor or manufacturer, the name is to be carefully covered until judging is over.
- 9. The Secretary reserves the right to refuse entry into the grounds, to any exhibit where there is reason to accept that it is diseased or dangerous. The Secretary also reserves the right to remove such an entry from the grounds.
- 10. No award ribbon, other than those awarded at the Show shall be placed on any exhibit whilst in the Showgrounds, without prior approval of the Steward for the section in which it is entered.
- 11. The committee shall abandon the Show, or any event contained therein, due to wet weather or any other reason which may make such course advisable. Should the show, or any event, be abandoned or cancelled then the exhibitor is entitled to a refund of any entry fees paid for those events not proceeded with. No cause for action, liability, or obligation shall be maintained or incurred because of the abandonment or cancellation.
- 12. No collectors will be allowed on the grounds except those authorized by the Committee. Any person infringing this regulation will be removed from the grounds.
- 13. A commission or rebate of 10% of all sales of exhibits effected by Auction or privately, before removal of same on the grounds shall be paid to the Society by the sellers for the benefit of General Funds no later than 14 days after the close of the Show.
- 14. Precautions will be taken to guard against fire and to protect the property of the Show, but the exhibits will not be insured at a cost to the Society.
- 15. The Society will not be responsible for any damage, accident, loss or mis-delivery which may be caused through, or by, any exhibit, competitive or non-competitive, and it shall be a condition of entry that the exhibitor shall hold the Society and it servants harmless and indemnified from and against legal action arising from such damages and the Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself liable for any accidents on the grounds or premises.
- 16. No stock entry will be allowed into the grounds without a permit which may be inspected at any time.
- 17. All prize money is to be collected from the office on the day of the Show. All prize money that is not claimed within one month of the show will be returned to General Funds.
- 18. The steward of each sections reserves the right to alter the program as they see fit.

### Section A - Supplier's statements about risk and duty of care

Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc and Goombungee – Haden Agricultural, Horticultural and Pastoral Society Incorporated (together the Suppliers) advise as set out below.

The handling of animals is a dangerous recreational activity as animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

Participation (including passive participation) in animal handling and/or physical competitions and/or Events at an agricultural show and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities contain elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. Physical competitions and activities, Events and use of the Suppliers' facilities are all dangerous recreational activities. This document is a risk warning for the purpose of the Civil Liability Act (2003) QLD and Australian Consumer Law. Any and all warranties, conditions and guarantees in relation to the competitions and activities, Events and use of Suppliers' facilities which are implied by Australian Consumer Law are excluded to the fullest extent permitted by law. This risk warning is given by or on behalf of the Suppliers. This document acts as an exclusion of liability under the Civil Liability Act (2003) QLD if the services supplied by the Suppliers are supplied without reasonable care and skill.

# Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities is a recreational activity for the purposes of the Civil Liability Act (2003) QLD and Australian Consumer Law

- 8. In handling animals, there is a risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by the animals.
- 9. I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for my safety in my participation of the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.
- 10. I am responsible for the condition of any tools and equipment and ensuring that they are appropriate for the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.
- 11. I use the Suppliers' facilities, including for the Event entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me, both obvious and inherent.
