Lemon Cake

1 cup castor sugar, 2 eggs, 125g butter, 1 1/2 cups SR flour, 1 rounded tablespoon of cornflour, 1/2 cup milk, 1 tablespoon grated lemon rind

Sift flour and cornflour, add sugar and lemon rind. Stir in softened butter, lightly beaten eggs and milk. Beat well for five minutes. Spoon mixture into 8" (20cm) round cake tin lined with greaseproof paper. Bake in moderate oven for approx. 40 minutes. Cool, ice on top with lemon flavoured lcing

Pikelets

1 egg, 1 cup SR Flour, ³/₄ cup milk, 1 teaspoon syrup, ¹/₄ cup sugar, vanilla

Beat egg, syrup and sugar. Add vanilla and milk. Add this mixture to flour, mixing with a whisk. Mix well. Add extra milk if necessary

Butter Bar

125g butter, 2 eggs, ³/₄ cup sugar, 1 teaspoon of vanilla, ¹/₂ cup milk, 1 ³/₄ cups S.R. Flour

Cream butter and sugar and add eggs, vanilla, sifted S.R. Flour and milk. Bake in bar tin at 180°C for 30 minutes or until cooked. Ice top only when cold

Lazy Daisy Cake

125g butter, 4 level tablespoons sugar, $\frac{1}{2}$ packet jelly crystals (any colour), 2 eggs, 1 $\frac{1}{3}$ cups S.R. flour, $\frac{1}{3}$ cup milk

Combine all ingredients in mixing bowl until blended. Beat for 3 minutes on medium speed with electric mixer. Bake in a bar tin at 180°C for 35 – 40 minutes or until cooked. Ice top only when cold and decorate with jelly bean daisies

Caramel Anzac Slice

Base – 125g butter, 2/3 cup brown sugar, ½ cup plain flour, ½ cup S.R. flour, ¾ cup coconut, ¾ cup rolled oats, 1 tbs boiling water

Filling – 1 can condensed milk, 30g butter, 1 tbs golden syrup

Topping – 60g butter, 1 tbs golden syrup, ³/₄ cup coconut, ³/₄ rolled oats

Prepare slice tin & heat oven to 180°C. Place dry ingredients in a bowl for base. Melt butter, add boiling water to butter, mix into dry ingredients. Press into slice tin & bake for 18 minutes.

While base is cooking, preparing filling. Place all ingredients into a microwave safe bowl, microwave for 30 second intervals until all combined. Put aside until base cools.

Prepare topping. Place dry ingredients in a bowl, melt butter and syrup together then mix through dry ingredients until combined, set aside until base is cooked.

Spead filling over base once cooked. Gently spread the topping over filling then bake in oven for a further 8 minutes or until light brown.


